How does it work?

Meetings

Youth conferences usually meet twice a month, sometimes weekly, alternating between meetings and service activities.

Coordinators

Two Vincentian Coordinators, or one Vincentian and one school staff member, assist with logistics, advising, and supporting young Vincentians.

Structure

A Conference President is elected by the group to lead the meeting and organize the conference's activities. They can appoint Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Spiritual Advisor or have the group elect these officers. Youth conference terms are 1-2 years.
