John Angotti is a full time music missionary who travels throughout many parts of the world providing inspirational music and faith witness to all ages through concerts, workshops, retreats, missions, conferences, and worship. He is originally from Clarksburg, West Virginia, and now resides in Nashville, Tennessee. He is a graduate of West Virginia University and the U.S. Military School of Music, where he was a member of the U.S. Navy Band as lead vocalist. John received his Master's Degree in Pastoral Studies from Catholic Theological Union in Chicago in 2013.

#### Casa de Paz

Sarah Jackson, founder of Casa, lives in one bedroom of this five-bedroom house which provides temporary accommodations for people who were temporarily detained in an ICE sweep. Relatives may also stay here as they await the release of their loved ones. Casa volunteers provide meals, clothes, transportation, and fellowship for guests of this house, and Sarah has also launched a donor campaign, publishes a regular newsletter, and has recently been working on her TED Talk.

Service project for SVDP young adults: Cleaning and preparing dorm rooms for families, making meals and desserts, visiting with the guests, making welcome signs and cards, stocking the clothes room, etc. There will also be time for Q and A with Sarah and other volunteers.

#### International Youth/YA Video Call

Did you know SVDP is an International network of charity? SVDP is active in 153 countries. Young Vincentians from around the world will gather for one hour on a video call to share about their countries and their involvement with St. Vincent de Paul. Youth & YA Conferences from around the country are invited to join on also.

#### **Poverty Simulation**

This poverty simulation experience is designed to help participants understand what it might be like to be a part of a typical low income family trying to survive from month-to-month. It is a simulation, not a game. The object is to sensitize participants to the realities of life faced by low income people.
