


Poverty Thresholds by Size of Family and Number of Related Children Under 18 Years Source: Current Population Survey (CPS)

EXPERIM

Census Bureau staff conducted the December 2022 Food Security Survey as a supplement to the Current Population Survey (CPS).

The CPS is a monthly labor force survey in which interviews are conducted in approximately 54,000 households across the nation.

December 2022 was the 28th time the Food Security Survey was conducted.

Currently data is collected annually in December from 2001 to 2021.

Attachment 8 contains the Food Security Supplement questions asked of all interviewed households in December 2022.

### **Food Insecurity**

Low food security (old label = Food insecurity without hunger): reports of reduced quality, variety, or desirability of diet. Little or no indication of reduced food intake.
Very low food security (old label = Food insecurity with hunger): reports of multiple indications of disrupted eating patterns and reduced food intake.
