#### **Home Visits**

- Bringing hope and financial resources to neighbors in need
- Developing friendships with those in need, listening and praying together

# Back2Work

- Providing low-income individuals with training, education, and mentoring
- Helping the unemployed/ underemployed become self-sufficient

# **Food Pantries**

 Sharing both fresh and non-perishable goods in neighborhoods impacted by poverty

# **Re-Entry Programs**

- Giving incarcerated individuals the resources and skills to succeed upon release
- Focusing on healthy relationships and stretching expectations

# **International Twinning**

- Sharing financial resources and building cross-cultural friendships
- Symbolically sharing the poverty of the poor and needy around the world

# **Systemic Change**

- Examining the root causes of a family's economic and societal status
- Working with neighbors in need to explore permanent life changes

#### **Disaster Relief Services**

- Helping those in situational poverty brought about by disasters
- Focusing on long-term recovery through personto-person services

# **Housing Programs**

- Providing resources around rent assistance, mortgage payments, and rapid rehousing programs
- Sharing safe and affordable housing solutions

#### **Charitable Pharmacies**

- Dispensing low- and no-cost prescriptions to low-income and uninsured individuals
- Improving positive health outcomes among the most vulnerable

- Providing meaningful employment and volunteer opportunities
