thoughtful, budget-conscious, and environmentally friendly way to give. Read more...


CONSIDER A CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITY

It's not too late to take advantage of a win/win opportunity as the 2025 tax year winds down.

A Charitable Gift Annuity provides a steady income for life, a 2025 tax year charitable tax deduction, and a legacy ultimately benefiting the Society of St. Vincent de Paul's national office and/or a local Council.

Annual income is based on one's age (or on two lives if both are 55+.) These can be funded with cash, stocks, and even a one-time IRA qualified charitable donation ("QCD") of up to \$54,000 if you are over 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ years young (note: special provisions apply to a QCD-funded charitable gift annuity).
