INTERNATIONAL TWINNING

International Twinning is a program offered through the National Council of the United States, Society of St. Vincent de Paul that allows aggregated Conferences and Councils in the U.S. to connect with aggregated Conferences and Councils in countries lacking the resources to conduct their works of charity. Twinned Conferences pray for one another, communicated regularly, and share financial resources.

The concept of mutual assistance dates back to the beginning of the Society in 1833. In 1979 Twinning was reinforced at the international level when those present at the "Plenary Meeting" of the CGI declared that "all monies collected in the name of the Society anywhere, belong in principle, to the poor of the world."



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Submit an application to the National Council. Receive your Twin's contact information and the International Twinning Guidelines. Start contributing and make an impact.

WHY TWINNING?

ACCOUNTABILITY. Contributions are sent to the National Office and wired quarterly to the National Council of the receiving country. The U.S. National Council absorbs all wire fees and ensures funds are delivered in accordance with the Society's Rule and U.S. regulations.

COMMUNICATION. Twins each share their culture and knowledge through regularly exchanged communication.

COMMUNITY. Twins pray for one another and grow in friendship.

IMPACT. American dollars can go a long way in impoverished countries. Just \$25 feeds a family of six in Peru for one week. \$75 builds a shelter for a family in Guatemala.
